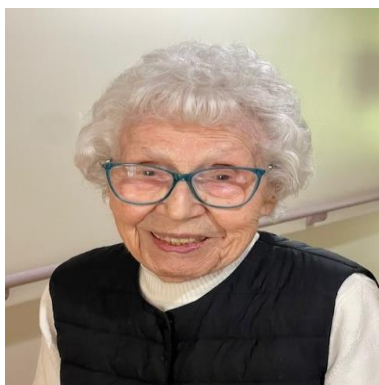

Dining Room chairs & Courtyard Furniture:

Please do not take the dining room chairs outside into the Courtyard. There are many outside patio chairs and benches available. Please do not leave the Courtyard chairs blocking walkways outside. It makes it difficult for residents to move about.

Pets:

Sun hats:
